- Most Recent College Transcript showing the completion of a Bachelor's degree, or impending completion, and enrollment in a current semester.
- A statement that briefly describes your extracurricular activities, community involvement (including the number of hours worked), work experience and achievements
- A student's statement in which you provide background information about yourself. Describe why you have chosen to pursue a career in the financial management field (300 words or less)
